

TECEDEIRAS LIBERTAS 2018

From the Latin: to set free or be at liberty. In modern terms also casual, cool. Libertas is the experimental label of Tecedeiras, where each year wine lovers can try a different, unique wine.

TERROIR

The two most planted grape varieties in the Douro, Tinta Roriz and Tinto Cão, served as inspiration to create this more traditional style wine, recalling the old-school claret wines of years gone by.

TASTING NOTES

COLOUR: Brilliant garnet red.

NOSE: Exuberantly perfumed. A heady combination of red fruit and spices.

PALATE: Smooth from the start, showing very silky tannins, light with excellent freshness. Above all elegant, this is a wine that presents a remarkable balance. It ends as it began, with a show of aromatics.

VINIFICATION

Manual harvest. Manual selection of bunches. De-stemming without crushing the berries.

The two varieties were fermented together in used 500L French oak barrels. Gentle *piegeage*.

After ageing for 19 months in used 500L barrels, we carry out a light fining and subsequent bottling. The wine is rested for a year before being released for sale.

All our wines are sealed with natural cork. The wines are neither filtered nor cold-stabilized, meaning reposts may form with age. We recommend decanting.
